## Flood Potential: Moderate

Issued to the following groups:

**The Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority advises that all watercourses in the upper watershed including the Pine River at Angus have crested and will gradually decline this week. Flows in the Lower Nottawasaga River downstream of Angus will continue to rise over the next 3 to 5 days as water is released from the Minesing Wetland. No significant flooding is anticipated however flooding of low lying areas will occur.**

The weather forecast is for above freezing temperatures with no precipitation until late in the week.

The public and especially children are advised to stay away from all area water bodies as fast, cold flowing water and slippery banks will result in dangerous conditions.

The Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority continues to monitor river and stream conditions and will issue additional messages as conditions warrant. This Flood Warning will be updated March 18, 2010.
