### **Camp Tiffin to offer strike camp if school strikes continue on Monday, November 7**

UTOPIA, Ontario (November 4, 2022) – In support of parents affected by school closures, if schools are closed past Friday November 4, Camp Tiffin will be open starting Monday, November 7, 2022.

Camp Tiffin is located at the 300+ acre Tiffin Centre for Conservation is 10 minutes outside of Barrie, Innisfil and Angus, featuring a mixture of wetlands, forests, open meadows and ancient lake beds. Activities include a mix of games, nature discovery, crafts and science.

“Although we’re not sure if schools will be closed on Monday, we want parents to know they can rely on us to provide child care,” continued Saunders. “Just because children are not in school, it doesn’t mean that learning has to stop. Their days spent at Camp Tiffin will include learning through engagement with nature, being off devices and socialization.”

All children ages 5-12 are welcome. Registration fees are \$45 per camper per day, and extended care is available for \$8 per camper per day. The camp is open from 9:00 a.m. to 4 p.m., with extended hours from 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
