Replacement fencing may be considered if the new fence is sited to provide significant environmental gain such as a wider buffer. Temporary fencing will be considered eligible but will require a signed agreement requiring the applicant to install the fence prior to livestock being introduced into the pasture every year and to maintain the fence while livestock are present in the pasture.
