Wedding ceremony in the Bernie Longson Memorial Pavilion

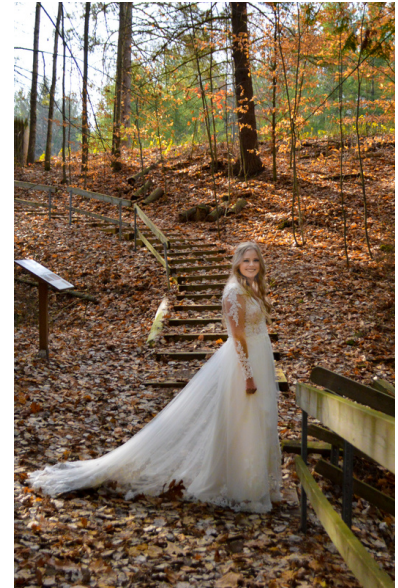
Capacity: 100 people

- Rehearsal visit (to be pre-arranged)
- Daily parking fees for two pre-wedding site visits
- Engagement and wedding photo/video permit (\$150 value)
- Use of on-site picnic tables

- Couples must provide a \$500 damage deposit and \$2 million liability insurance
- Couples must adhere to NVCA rules around décor, candles, confetti, etc.
- There are accessible outhouses, but no running water or hydro at the site
- No alcohol is permitted at Fort Willow
- Prices are subject to change
